POSITION

The Operations Program Manager (OPM) is a management-level position. Under the Direction of the Assistant Manager, the OPM is in charge of the day-to-day operations side of the District. The OPM is a member of the safety committee, and enforces all District policies, programs and standards. Morale and discipline of employees, including, if necessary, the firing of an employee are among the responsibilities of this position, following written bookkeeping and approval by the Manager and Assistant Manager.

IDEAL CANDIDATE

Educational Background:

- Bachelor's degree (B.S.) from a four-year college or university, and five plus years related experience.

Skills/Knowledge/Experience in:

- The principles and practices of vector and vector-borne disease surveillance and control, particularly as it relates to mosquito control methods.
- Basic mosquito biology and ecology; preferred experience in controlling mosquitoes.
- Data collection in office and field setting, record keeping, data analysis, general safety, and maintaining accurate inventory.
- Relating mathematical concepts such as rate, ratio, percentages, area and volume to practical situations.
- Calibration and mosquito control equipment maintenance.
- Reading, analyzing, and interpreting common scientific and technical journals, professional journals, technical procedures, or governmental regulations.
